Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.

- **Dogs may enter an ASCA agility trial without an ASCA number, however their Q's will not be tracked. If your dog is an ASCA registered Australian Shepherd, fill in your dog's registration number where indicated on the entry form. If your dog is not an ASCA registered Australian Shepherd and you would like to earn ASCA titles, you will need to obtain an ASCA tracking number for your dog. Once you have an ASCA tracking number, use it as your dog's "ASCA Registration Number" on all entry forms.**
- Dogs entering the standard division jump height classes 20" or less (with height less than or equal to 20") that do not have a permanent ASCA, AKC or NADAC height card must be measured. Dogs entering 20+" or 24" jump heights are exempt (includes Veteran and Junior Handler Division dogs entered in the 16"+ jump height classes). Copies of approved height cards may either be mailed with trial entry form or presented to trial secretary at trial check-in.

Awards will be presented Monday following the show/trial. Dog here means both sexes.

Libby Graham Memorial Most Versatile Australian Shepherd:

- ASCA National MVA rules will apply regarding scoring.
 - Highest score from Sat. and/or Sun. stock runs will be used;
 - Highest obedience score from Sat. or Sun. Novice, Open or Utility will be used;
 - Regular Agility classes allowed in the ASCA rules will be used;
 - The ASCA MVA conformation evaluation point system will be used;
- Only qualifying scores in stock, agility and obedience can be used.
- If there is a tie, the stock score will be used to break the tie.
- Bitches in heat are not eligible to enter MVA since they may NOT run in Obedience/Agility.
- Please note on your entry blank if you are entering MVA. \$5.00 fee

Libby Graham Memorial Most Versatile Junior Award:

- Junior must compete in the MVJ evaluation and one performance event - agility, obedience and/or stock. All scores count.
- Non-regular classes are accepted for this award (such as: Sub-Novice, Working Junior Handler etc.)
- Please note on your entry blank if you are entering MVJ. No fee.

Hard Luck Stock Award:

To be awarded at the discretion of the stock judges based on Saturday & Sunday stock trials.

High Point Conformation Dog with a Stock Title:

One point for each dog beaten over the 4 days of conformation shows. The stock title has to be confirmed prior to the first show. In the event of a tie, the dog with the highest level stock title will win, in the event of a second tie the dog with the highest level cattle title will win.

High Score Obedience Dog with a Stock Title:

The dog with the highest average from the Sat. and Sunday obedience trials. Only qualifying scores will be used. The sum of the highest qualifying scores from each trial will be divided by 2 to compute the score for this award. The

stock title must be confirmed prior to the first show. If there is a tie, the highest obedience level will win, in the event of a second tie the dog with the highest level stock title will win with cattle having preference, then sheep, then ducks.

High Score Stock Dog with a Conformation Title:

The dog must compete in no fewer than 3 trials. The sum of the three highest qualifying scores on stock, from at least 3 different trials will be divided by 3 to compute the score for this award. The conformation title must be confirmed prior to the show.

Most Promising Started Aussie Buckle: Sponsored by Hans Anklam and Ford: Judges’ discretion based on 3 trials.

Most Promising Started Other Breed: Judges’ discretion based on all 3 trials.

Weekend High Scoring – Advanced, Open and Started entry:

Custom Metal Picture Frames will be awarded to Highest Scoring Advanced entry, Highest Scoring Open entry and Highest Scoring Started entry. The highest score is the average of 3 scores from any of the 5 trials and must include a score from Course A and Course B. Awards will be based on the highest class level at which your dog is entered.

Please indicate on the entry form which Weekend Trophy Awards you are competing for.

GENERAL INFORMATION: This is an ASCA sanctioned show and all ASCA rules apply (www.asca.org). Dogs over 6 months of age must have proof of ASCA registration available. CASA, the Show Secretaries, the Course Directors and respective memberships assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by any exhibitor, handler, dog, property, children or spectator. All dogs must be crated or leashed except while competing.

Entry fees will not be returned if the show cannot be opened or be completed due to riots, civil disturbances, acts of God, public emergencies or other events beyond the control of CASA. Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the Show Committee, ASCA, show veterinarian or the judge.

TRIAL INFORMATION: Substitutions are allowed providing the dog is owned by same owner. Draw for run order will be after trial registration closes. Bitches in heat will run in order of draw, but must be crated and exercised away from the competition. Overflow judges may be hired and the limit of runs per day as well as judging assignments may change. All breeds recognized by ASCA as herding breeds are eligible to enter the trial.

Stock to be used: 5 head per run of Khaki Campbell ducks, 3-5 head per run of wool and/or hair sheep and 3-5 head per run of 300 to 800# black angus or mixed calves. Owners of dogs will be responsible for all injuries to livestock; replacement cost per duck is \$25, per sheep is \$150, per calf is \$750 unless posted otherwise at time of trial.

Limit of 60 stock runs per TRIAL not to exceed:

Sheep (20 run limit), Cattle (20 run limit), & Ducks (20 run limit)

Based on entries, the above listed limits may change and judging assignments may change.

Any changes will be posted at the Trial Registration Desk in advance of the Trial starting.

An overflow judge will be hired if entries merit.
